From the Pastor

The Vatican Council II document on the Liturgy, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, explains that the 'parish represents the visible Church' (#42). What this means is that what we do in the parish becomes the concrete manifestation of our identity and mission as a Church. In fact, everything that we do must be consistent with the true nature of the Church. Doing follows being; mission follows vocation.

So what is it that we ought to do in the parish? St. Pope John Paul II, in one of his addresses, said about the parish: "The parish institution is meant to provide the church's great services: prayer in common and the reading of God's Word, celebrations especially that of the Eucharist, catechesis for children and the adult catechumenate, the on-going formation of the faithful, communications designed to make the Christian message known, services of charity and solidarity and the local work of movements" (cf. CIC 515). The parish, therefore, is 'evangelical' in nature – for it is tasked to share the 'evangelium', i.e., the gospel of our Lord and to make the Christian message known.

In our parish, we seek to do this work of evangelization through the renewal in the Liturgy, particularly in our celebration of the Eucharist, the on-going formation and catechesis of all, the support of various ministries so that they in turn can build up the parish, and the attention to works of charity. This is how I would summarize what we are as a parish.

In light of the care we wish to give to one of the missions of the parish, therefore, <u>please be informed of the change in our Sunday Morning Mass time which will take effect on September 7, 2014.</u> You may recall the poll we have undertaken related to this. You have voted and the majority has chosen to change our 8:30 AM Sunday Mass to <u>8:00 AM (30 minutes earlier.) Hence, beginning September 7, our Sunday morning Mass schedule will be 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM.</u> We hope that this change will benefit our Sunday School-Faith Formation Program.

May Christ who is the center of everything that we do bless us. Thank you.

Faith Formation Reorganization

We have done some reorganizing on the Faith Formation Team. We are excited for the changes, new team members, and fresh insight:

- ♦ Lisa McGuigan will continue to oversee the entire Faith Formation Program; Baptism through High School, and will coordinate /teach the Middle School Youth Group Program.
- ♦ Violet Wanner will coordinate Children's Liturgy of the Word, Preschool through Elementary Faith Formation, First Communion and Vacation Bible School.
- Ashley Ludwig has joined our team as the High School Youth Ministry Coordinator and will coordinate and teach the High School Youth Group.
- ♦ Monica Conrow is returning as our Volunteer Confirmation Coordinator. She will coordinate and teach Confirmation Classes.

Faith Formation Registration

Registration will begin for Faith Formation; Preschool through High School at the end of August. Forms are available on the parish website. Go to the home page and scroll to the very bottom of the page to find the link beneath "I want to register my child in Faith Formation." Only one form is needed per family.

Information about Faith Formation programs can be found on the parish website beneath the Faith Formation Tab. Here you will find information by age group.

Sacrament of First Holy Communion

First Eucharist preparation is a two year program. The first year is for children first grade and older. Within this first year, children begin learning in community and are introduced to the basics of our Catholic Faith. (The first year may have been completed at another parish. You will need to provide the parish name and contact information.) The second year is for children second grade and older. Within this year, children will focus on the Church's teachings specifically pertaining to the Sacrament of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

Children must be baptized prior to entering the second year of the program. If your child has not been baptized, or was baptized into another Christian faith, please contact Violet Wanner in the parish office.

Registration takes place at the end of August and beginning of September. Classes begin on Sunday mornings mid-September. Please use the Faith Formation registration form as noted under Faith Formation registration. Note there is an additional charge of \$25 for the second year of the program.

Sacrament of Confirmation

This sacrament is for High School Youth ninth grade and older. The classes begin on Sunday, October 12 form 1:00 pm to 2:45 pm. Classes will meet approximately twice per month with two required retreats, fall and spring.

Registration takes place at the end of August and beginning of September. Please use the Faith Formation registration form as noted under Faith Formation Registration. Note the fee includes two retreats and several materials that will be utilized throughout the year. The fee can be paid all at once or in payments throughout the year.
