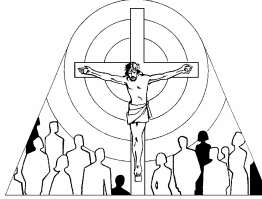
Principals in the Archdiocese are away at retreat. Please keep them in your prayers.
